



Gorham Youth Soccer Association Game Day COVID-19 Guidelines

Here is what all families can expect and what we will expect of them on game day. There may be a few differences in how each club handles this, but these are the protocols the GYSA Board has adopted for the 2020 season. Please share with your families so there are no surprises.

- Do not attend event if exhibiting or feeling any symptoms of COVID-19
- Wait in vehicles until the field of play is clear from a previous game
- **ONLY ONE SPECTATOR PER PLAYER IN ATTENDANCE**
- Any parent/guardian/sibling/guest outside a vehicle counts as a spectator
- Inside a vehicle means inside the passenger compartment. Windows down are ok. Motorcycles or bicycles not ok; back of truck beds not ok; open tailgates of SUV/vans not ok; open top convertible not ok.
- You are a spectator if you are on this property and out of your vehicle, even if you are in the parking lot or “far away” from the field of play
- Please be courteous to those viewing from inside their vehicle and do not park in front row spots if you are the spectator out on the field
- All spectators attending the game to sit on the opposite sidelines from the team bench areas, and separate by home and away team. Center line should be divider.
- All coaches/spectators must wear a mask and socially distance by 6ft at all times outside of their vehicle
- **Players Only:** Wear a face covering at all times outside of their vehicle when not physically playing in the game (face coverings are not required on the field of play)
- All Gorham fields are “carry-in / carry-out”
- Portable bathrooms are on-site. They are provided for convenience only and are use at your own risk as they are not maintained to generally accepted CDC guidelines.

Should GYSA protocols not be followed by coaches, players, parents/spectators, GYSA reserves the right to remove anyone from the field or suspend play. Additional disciplinary action can be taken by your respective Club’s Board for all violations.
